The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer by Brother Jerry Manning and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Union County Fiscal Court met in a regular meeting with Judge O’Nan presiding. Magistrates present were Wyatt, Ricketts, Byrnes, and Clements. Magistrate Floyd was not present

The minutes from the July 9, 2019 Fiscal Court meeting were accepted as read.

Amelia Wilson, Congressman Comer’s field representative announced that she will have open office hours in Union County on August 13, 2019 from 10:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

Judge O’Nan advised that when the original salary schedule was set a typo was made on Leo Rednour and Tony Ratley’s 2019/2020 hourly rate. Leo Rednour’s hourly rate should be \$18.75, and Tony Ratley’s hourly rate should be \$15.25. Magistrate Clements made a motion to correct the typos and change Leo Rednour’s salary to \$18.75 per hour and Tony Ratley’s to \$15.25 per hour, seconded by Magistrate Byrnes, motion carried.

All claims are to be paid.

Judge O’Nan advised that the Hwy. 60 project has started. Judge O’Nan also advised that we have still not heard back from the grant for air packs, but assured everyone that if we are not funded the Fiscal Court will use coal severance funds to replace the air packs that will expire in October, 2019.

Magistrate Wyatt made a motion to go into executive session per KRS: 61.810(1)(c), seconded by Magistrate Wyatt, motion carried.

Magistrate Ricketts made a motion to return to regular session, seconded by Magistrate Clements, motion carried.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Clements, seconded by Magistrate Byrnes, motion carried.
