The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a prayer by Bother Jerry Manning and the pledge to the American Flag.

The Union County Fiscal Court met in a regular meeting with Magistrate Clements presiding due to Judge O’Nan not being present. Magistrates present were Wyatt, Floyd, Byrnes, and Clements. Magistrate Ricketts was not in attendance.

The minutes from the September 10, 2019 Fiscal Court meeting were accepted with a correction to the second motion on the purchase of the Vonac truck, the second motion should have been from Magistrate Floyd, minutes accepted with that change.

Melissa Coker presented the Regional Development Agency Assistance Program annual project completion report. Magistrate Floyd made a motion to approve said report, seconded by Magistrate Byrnes, motion carried.

Magistrate Floyd made a motion to set bid dates for September 25, 2019 and October 2, 2019 and to open bids on October 8, 2019 for the dredging at the Uniontown boat ramp., seconded by Magistrate Byrnes, motion carried.

Magistrate Clements presented the agreement and resolution o9r the 2019 flex funds in the amount of \$204,123.00, Magistrate Floyd made a motion to approve said agreement and resolution, seconded by Magistrate Wyatt, roll was called

Mr. Reburn presented the Court with quotes for supplies to repair current raised beds. Magistrate Clements made a motion to take the quotes under advisement to show Judge O’Nan and Magistrate Ricketts, seconded by Magistrate Floyd, motion carried.

Magistrate Wyatt reminded everyone that the Corn Festival is September 26-28, 2019.

Magistrate Floyd advised everyone that Judge O’Nan issued a burn ban on Monday, September 23, 2019 until further notice, and read the executive order aloud.

Magistrate Wyatt and Magistrate Clements will review the claims for the second quarter of this fiscal year.

Mr. Reburn advised the Court that he wished we could make festival’s like the corn festival nonsmoking. He cannot be around smoking so he is not able to enjo9y the festivals around the community.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Wyatt, seconded by Magistrate Byrnes, motion carried.
