## UNION COUNTY FISCAL COURT MEETING June 25, 2024

The meeting opened at 9:00 a.m. with a Prayer by Judge Adam O'Nan, and the Pledge to the American Flag.

The Union County Fiscal Court met in a regular scheduled meeting with Judge/Executive Adam O'Nan presiding. Magistrates present were Wyatt, Ricketts, Jones and Girten.

The minutes from the June 10, 2024, Fiscal Court Meeting were approved as presented.

Judge O'Nan opened the bid for (2) Sheriff Vehicles. The bid was as follows:

• Wade Ford 2024 or 2025 Ford Interceptor \$47,375.00 Magistrate Wyatt made a motion to take the bid under advisement and to bring back before the Court at our July 9, 2024, Fiscal Court Meeting, seconded by Magistrate Girten, motion carried.

Magistrate Girten made a motion to declare a sound system and speaker from County Clerk Garrick Thompson's office as surplus and to dispose of it, seconded by Magistrate Jones, motion carried.

Judge O'Nan presented the Reverse Salt Auction Bids that we received from KACo. The bids were as follows:

Magistrate Wyatt made a motion to award the bid to IBG Magic of Kentuckiana, seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Judge O'Nan presented the second reading and adoption of the 2024/2025 Budget in the amount of \$29,222,987.98. Magistrate Jones made a motion to approve the second reading and adoption of the 2024/2025 Budget, seconded by Magistrate Girten, motion carried.

Judge O'Nan presented a Veteran Reserved Parking Space Sign to the Court. Adrian Bambini our Regional Representative for Kentucky Veterans Hall of Fame donated this sign in hopes the Court would approve setting aside a parking space (or more) specifically for Veterans. Additional signs may be purchased for \$50 from the KY Veterans Hall of Fame. Magistrate Jones made a motion to approve setting aside a parking space specifically for Veterans, seconded by Magistrate Girten, motion carried.

Claims are to be paid as presented.

Magistrate Ricketts made a motion to approve an additional claim for the Sheriff's Office printer in the amount of \$5,495.00 to Tri-State Mailing Company, seconded by Magistrate Jones, motion carried.

Magistrate Ricketts made a motion to approve transfers, seconded by Magistrate Girten, motion carried.

Magistrate Jones made a motion to approve the May 2024, Treasurer Report, seconded by Magistrate Ricketts, motion carried.

Magistrate Jones and Magistrate Wyatt agreed to be on the July-September Quarterly Claim Committee.

Judge O'Nan and all Magistrates gave updates on their districts with nothing that required movement from the Court.

There being no further business to come before the Court, a motion to adjourn was made by Magistrate Jones, seconded by Magistrate Girten, motion carried.
